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President's Message

I am happy to pen my message for the annual Trust Fund and project report, as the President of the CTF. The past year continued to be a successful one for our projects and Trust funds, thanks to the generous support of our donors. I take this opportunity to thank all our donors who continue to support the schools in spite of the prevailing unfavourable economic situation. I also thank the Trustees of CTF and the PPA UK for their great support which account for the smooth administration of the projects and Funds.

I am very happy that our sponsored students are continuing to do well in their respective schools. We also have several students following undergraduate courses in various Universities and Colleges across Sri Lanka. The students who wish to follow vocational training courses after leaving school are also supported to follow the courses of their choice. Some of our students who were supported under this programme have chosen to find employment after completing A/Ls and are now in a position to support themselves.

CTF's focus for 2020 is to help children with special needs and other mental health issues. This would be at SJC and CGC, but we could extend it to other schools in Jaffna. We want to help children with dyslexia, who if correctly diagnosed can be given the extra help and time they need, as well as children with mental health issues such as depression and anxiety, and children with Autism spectrum disorders or other learning difficulties. This initiative would include giving teachers the correct training to be able to properly teach these children. While the Ministry of Education stresses the importance of inclusive education, neither the training colleges nor the universities provide the training for the teachers in managing a class where there are students with different levels of learning abilities. This project could also start a very important dialogue about mental health, which will assist in ending the stigma surrounding the subject. If the negative attitude towards mental health is decreased then it will be easier for the people who need help, not only to get help but to feel comfortable asking for it. This will help not only the students, but Jaffna.

I once again thank all our donors, past pupils and well-wishers for your support which has been instrumental in the undertaking of several successful projects and Trust funds. With your support, we will continue to work together towards the achievement of our goals in the coming year.
